Travis Leach spent 14 years in a vicious cycle of homelessness, addiction, and incarceration. In 2013, he entered a detox facility and was set to get clean and start focusing on rebuilding his life. In 2014, he began taking classes at GCC in pursuit of an Associates degree for transfer in Sociology. He received his degree in the Spring of 2019 and has begun his undergraduate studies at Cal State Los Angeles. He currently works as the Special Assistant to the Dean of Student Services as well as a campus navigator for the Center of Reentry Pathways at GCC. Now that Travis has cleaned up his life, it is very important for him to try and help others who might still be in struggles he once found himself in.
